Description	CROWN [®] Lamp Oil is an ultra-refined lamp oil in clear plastic bottles and is designed to burn cleanly in brass and glass oil lamps.
Prominent Features	Fuel for oil lamps with mechanical burners.
	Clear, ultra-refined formula.
	• Unscented.
Uses	Fuel for oil lamps with mechanical burners.
Limitations	Not to be used in oil candles.
Application	Remove chimney and fill base with Crown Lamp Oil. Do not overfill. Lamp oil level should be at least 3/4" inch below top of neck. Screw burner assembly back into base. Allow 5 minutes for wick to absorb oil. Raise wick to light. Once lit, replace chimney and adjust wick so that it does not extend above the top of the metal combustion chamber. Wick height is extremely important. The wick should never be visible above the dome of the burner.
Disposal	The generation of waste should be avoided or minimized whenever possible. Empty containers or liners may retain some product residues. This material and its container must be disposed of in a safe way. Dispose of surplus and non-recyclable products via a licensed waste disposal contractor. Disposal of this product, solutions, and any by-products should at all times comply with the requirements of environmental protection and waste disposal legislation and any regional local authority requirements. Avoid dispersal of spilt material and runoff and contact with soil, waterways, drains, and sewers.
Storage	Store in dry, cool, well-ventilated areas away from strong oxidizing agents, food, and drink. Keep away from heat and ignition sources. Transfer only to approved containers having correct labeling. Keep containers tightly closed when not in use. Protect containers against physical damage. Containers that have been opened must be carefully resealed and kept upright to prevent leakage. Containers are hazardous when empty as they contain product residue. Do not cut, drill, weld, braze solder, grind, or perform similar operations on or near empty containers. Use appropriate containment to avoid environmental contamination. Ventilate closed areas. Keep out of reach of children.
