

**Crown® Lacquer Thinner - CR.LT - January 17, 2024**

Description	CROWN® Lacquer Thinner is a general purpose, medium-dry grade lacquer thinner for use in thinning clear and pigmented nitrocellulose lacquers. Excellent for cleaning brushes, rollers and spray equipment. Good also as a parts cleaner and degreaser.

Limitations	Do not use to thin automotive lacquers.
Application	Carefully read all cautions and instructions before use. Protect hands with solvent-resistant gloves, and eyes with safety glasses. Open can slowly to relieve pressure. Add CROWN® Lacquer Thinner slowly with good agitation until desired viscosity is achieved.
Disposal	Contains organic solvents which may cause adverse effects to the environment if disposed of improperly. Place empty containers in normal refuse for disposal. Contact your local sanitation department or household hazardous waste coordinator for information concerning possible reuse or disposal of unused solvent-containing products.
Storage	Store in dry, cool, well-ventilated areas away from strong oxidizing agents, strong reducing agents, strong acids, strong bases, acid anhydrides, aliphatic amines, alkalis, perchlorates, halogens, halogenated compounds, alkalis, and rubber various plastics, food, and drink. Keep away from heat and ignition sources. Transfer only to approved containers having correct labeling. Keep containers tightly closed when not in use. Protect containers against physical damage. Containers that have been opened must be carefully resealed and kept upright to prevent leakage. Containers are hazardous when empty as they contain product residue. Do not cut, drill, weld, braze, solder grind or perform similar operations on or near empty containers. Use appropriate containment to avoid environmental contamination. Ventilate closed areas. Keep out of reach of children.
